

## PACKING LIST PHOTO/VIDEO SAFARI

## Equipment List for Photo and Video Safari

- 2 Camera house with 2 different lenses (1 works but keep in mind its very dusty so not ideal to change lens in the field).
- Telephoto lenses (ideally covering 24-70mm and 100-400mm range, up to 600mm can be nice, also 16-35mm nice for wide landscape or close animals).
- CLP filter nice for gorilla trekking also for safari, Variable ND filter as well.
- Lens cleaning equipment, Blower ball for dust, Sensor cleaning (cleaning is very important because all the dust).
- Extra batteries.
- Battery charger.
- Power bank.
- Memory cards. Laptop and SSD hard drives to backup photos.
- Camera bag.
- Zip lock bags (to protect equipment from dust) but note plastic bags are banned in Tanzania/Uganda/Kenya so use a cloth alternative!
- Beanbag (to provide stability for your camera, we have some in the car as well).
- Video head with leveler head that you can mount in 3/8 screw (we have the screw bolts when the car is modify for photo/video).
- Clamp with 3/8 screw so you can attach your video head to the top of the car (steal pillars around the roof).
- Tripod for walking safari.
- Multiple electrical plug adapter (or a power strip) that works for Tanzania outlet.
- Camera Rain cover for gorilla trekking and walk safari
- Lens Sun hood
- External monitor for Videographers
- Drones are not allowed in Tanzania and Uganda if you don't get special permit that is very hard to get.
